The Falmouth Wheelers Club was formed in 2000, as these things are, with a letter to the local paper and a few like-minded cyclists getting together in the pub. The first Sunday meet-up saw 33 cyclists go out in three groups, with ride distances of 8, 11 and 20 miles. and it wasn't long before there was a bank account, someone "volunteering" to write ride reports and discussions about trips to France. Social group rides just over the Channel have continued each year since, apart from during Covid, and expeditions further afield, to Ireland, the Pyrenees and the Med have been a regular addition to the club calendar. Many members also enjoy longer rides in the UK undertaking the John-o-Groats-to-Lands-End Ride and many of the organised Sportive and Audax events held throughout the year.

The club has come, and cycled, a long way since 2000 but still retains its small friendly feeling - a club that welcomes new and old members alike.

Pathfinder Rides

Every month we arrange a Pathfinder ride for the whole club to take part in. This is a chance to show off the club jerseys en masse and get together with all the members. The organiser (any member can be an organiser) will let us know the start point. This is usually somewhere out of Falmouth. We will then ride for about 25 miles, including a lunch stop before returning to the start point. Keen riders will cycle to the start point, ride the loop and then cycle home again (about 60-75 miles). It's a great way to meet everyone and encourages new or less experienced riders to visit new roads. Car sharing can be arranged via Facebook, WhatsApp groups or at our meet-ups.

Advisory for all Members

- Cycling insurance. Cover through <u>Cycling UK</u> or other insurance providers can give you peace of mind as well as member discounts and benefits.
- Carry the essentials. What you need on a ride depends on how long you're heading out for. Here's a good article from British Cycling as a starting point.
- Download <u>What3words</u> to your phone. This App will pinpoint where you are to a 3-meter radius. It's ideal in emergencies, but it can also be a good way to arrange a meeting point.
- Regularly check your bike over for wear and tear and carry out maintenance.
- Register on and check the club website on a regular basis.
- Treat all road users with respect and cycle responsibly adhering to the Highway Code and/or Road Regulations for the country you are in.
